About Us

The House Urban Arts Initiative Inc is proud to announce its 5th year as one of Madison's premier dance companies. With the expansion of our center we have been able to expand programming. Urban arts in the Madison area continues to fully operate and have a to call home. The House Inc operates classes Monday-Sunday for youth ages 4-18, as well as adult health and wellness classes.

THI is an African American performing arts center in Dane County and surrounding areas to offer black & brown underserved communities access to performing arts training and much more. You may have heard about our programs in the past. In 2007, our dance program was on BET (Black Entertainment Television) national live sitcom 106&Park Dance Competition. The House Inc program Crushin All Force won 1st place on live television representing Wisconsin. We've also graced the campaign trail of our former president Barack Obama, even performing on many local stages such as the Overture Center of the Arts, MyArts Theater, even the men's Badger Basketball game at the Kohls Center.

Our 2022 budget allowed us to cover two out of 8 part-time staff & volunteers, one year mortgage, and six Regional & National performances/competitions. We're a for artist-by-artist facility meaning, all programs are run by artists. We plan rehearsals, arrange fundraisers, make costumes, choreograph, and operate the center on a 80% volunteer basis.

This season, we are hoping to minimize costs for families by gaining sponsors who believe in us. Black performing arts have never been considered in this community before, however we work just as hard, train just as hard, and operate at a full capacity for our students and families.

We all have a passion for the future of urban arts in this community and we would like to invite you to be a part of it!


